Table Captain Tip Sheet

To buy the table or to not buy the table?

It is common for people to imagine that when table captains buy tickets for their guests that their guests will make more generous donations at the event. This isn't what experience shows.

If this is your intention and you'd like to buy tickets for your table, we recommend being clear when your guests confirm attendance with you that you're hoping people will consider a minimum gift of \$150 or \$25 monthly recurring donation.

What does "Lead giving at your table by making a generous pledge yourself" mean?

We're excited about the possibilities of what we can do together to support healing for more survivors and ensure that those who have suffered the impact of childhood sexual abuse can have a door opened for them to life-changing healing at Shepherd's Counseling Services.

Everyone's situation is different. Some options for making a generous gift could be choosing a gift amount of \$150, \$250, \$1,000, \$2,500, \$5,000, \$10,000 or a recurring monthly gift or \$25/month, \$50/month, \$100/month or more.

We see our Fall Luncheon as a true celebration of healing and this good-hearted community of compassionate people coming together to bring healing to as many people as we can!

Lead commitments help to inspire others to invest in bringing the greatest support for healing to help survivors find a new beginning.

What is a Lead Commitment?

If you would like to share with the Development staff (Jill) how much you plan to contribute at the event, we can inspire our guests by sharing information anonymously about the commitment that others in the room have made towards supporting this mission.

We can, for instance, announce that we already have \$10,000 in committed gifts for the luncheon inspiring others to greater heights in what we can do together for this good and important cause.
